Introduction

This information guide should be used in conjunction with the Accessing a Designated Living Option from the Hospital / Accessing a Designated Living Option from the Community Information and Decision Making Guide for Patient and Families.

This information guide contains

1. Further tools to help you consider the costs associated with the move – Financial Screening Tool, Financial Calculator and an overview of Long Term Care.
2. The details of the Long Term Care living option sites in Calgary Zone that can meet your assessed needs. The next step is to research your preferred living option sites.

Please use the Decision Making Worksheet and the Living Options Sites Worksheet in the Accessing a Designated Living Option from the Hospital / Accessing a Designated Living Option from the Community Information and Decision Making Guide for Patients and families in order to compile your research.

What to expect:

- The case manager needs to be notified of one or more preferred sites.
- The Designated Living Option Approval Letter should be completed with the support of your case manager.
- In some instances client's care needs require a specialty site and/or suite to best meet their needs. Client's waitlisted for specialty sites unfortunately will not have an option of choosing a facility for placement as the specialty site(s) is the only option at this time. The client will be offered a specialty site bed when one becomes available and it is the expectation that this bed will be accepted by the client.

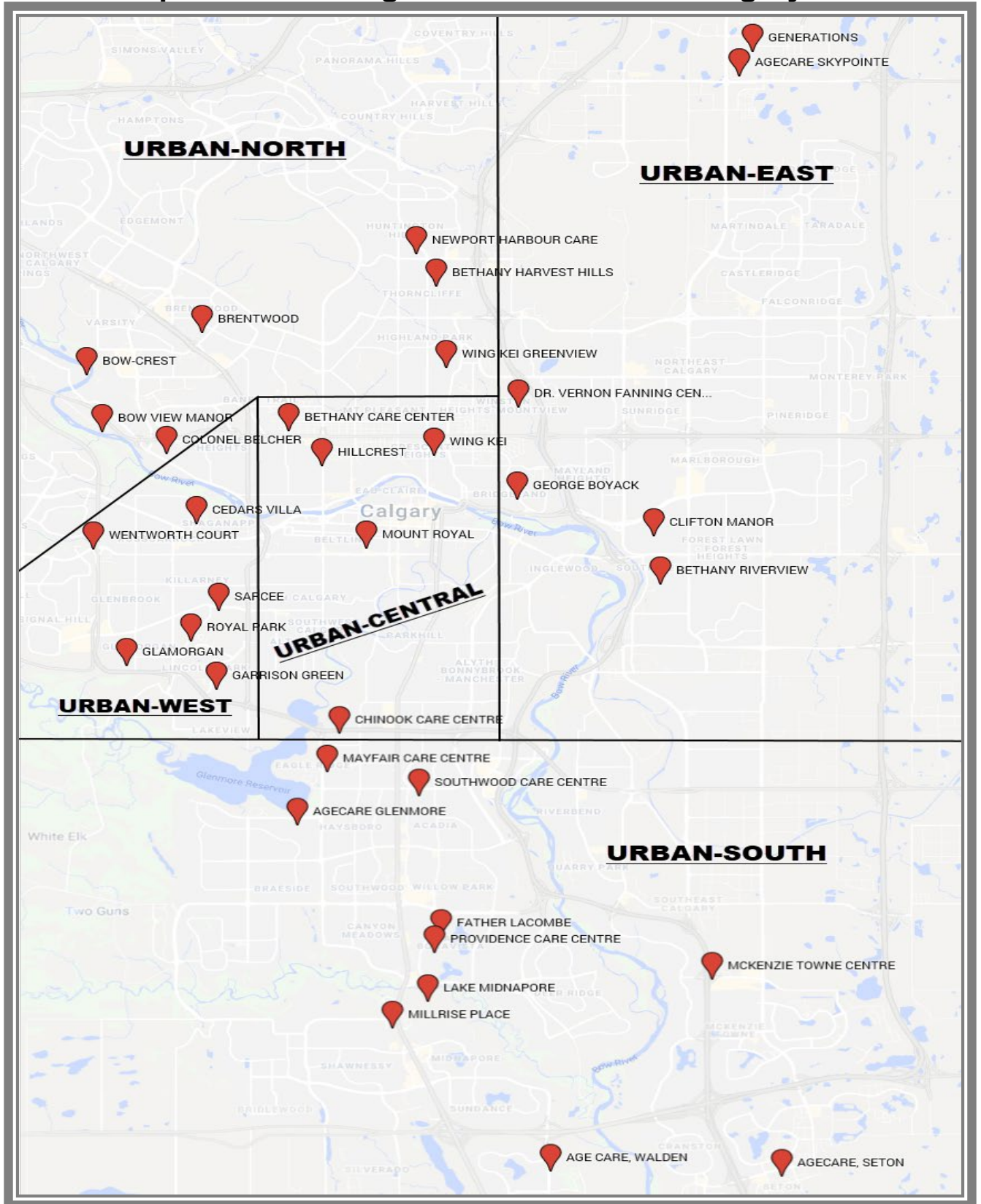

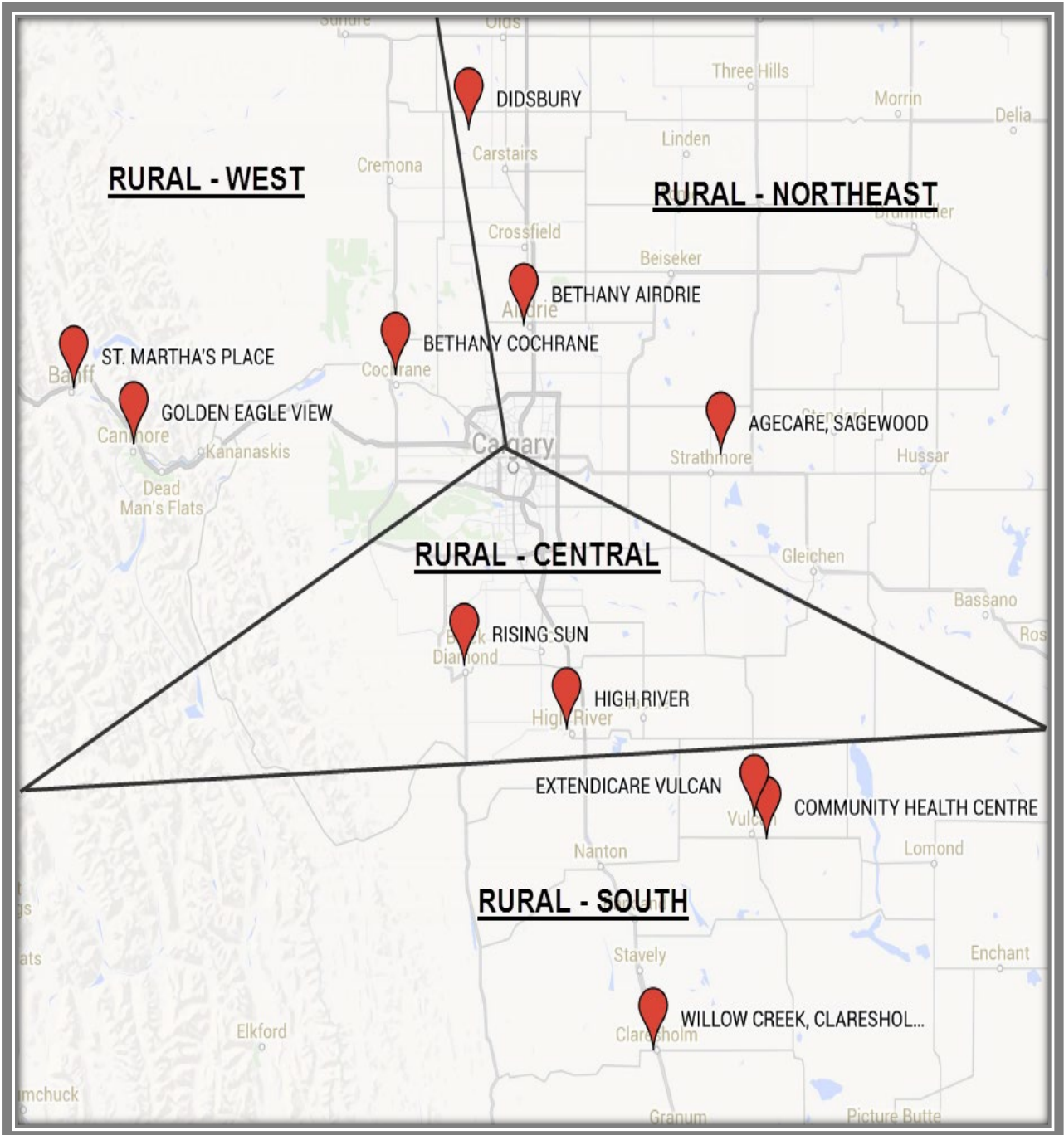

Once a facility has availability and you are appropriate based upon waitlist prioritization, your details will be reviewed by the facility and considered for admission. If this facility is your most preferred designated living option (choice #1) and you accept, the date that you move into the facility is the date you will be removed from the waiting list.

If the facility is not your most preferred designated living option, you will be offered a space at an alternate designated living option while you wait for your most preferred. Every effort will be made to consider the things you identified as being most important when you decided on your most preferred choice.

If you accept an alternate designated living option, your name will remain on the waitlist for transfer to your most preferred choice. There will be regular opportunities to confirm if you still wish to remain on the waitlist and to answer any specific questions you may have.

You are also invited to contact your Transition Service Coordinator at any time to change your choices/ remove yourself from the waiting list or provide any changes to your health status.
